

On 25 May 2018, the new EU General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679 (GDPR) took effect. Therefore, we would like to provide you with certain information about the data we process, also why and how we do it.

MEATEST spol. s r. o. is responsible as the controller of your data which we collect and process while doing business with you and your company.

1. We collect and store your Personal Data (PD) for following reasons:

- a) To fulfil the conditions of our contract or to take measures accepted before signing the contract upon your request
- b) To fulfil the legal obligations
- c) In purpose of our eligible interests
- d) For completion of task done in public interest or in exercise of public authority, we are entrusted to
- e) To protect ours or other individual's vital interests
- f) For any purpose specifically defined in your free and whenever revocable consent.

2. For processing your PD we use services of external subjects, of which we are obliged to inform you. List of these external processors is available upon request.

3. While processing your PD we may share them with another administrator of PD. However, we are obliged to inform you about such an action.

4. Personal data processed by MEATEST may be provided to administrative authority according to valid legislation, without your consent.

5. Your rights

You have rights as an individual which you can exercise under certain circumstances in relation to your PD we hold.

You have the right to get our confirmation whether we process your personal data (PD) or not. In case we do, you have the right to access these data and following information:

- a) Reasons for processing your PD
- b) Category of PD we hold
- c) Identification of recipients, to whom your PD have been or shall be shown. Especially recipients from international organizations and countries outside EU and EFTA.
- d) How long your data are going to be stored
- e) All available information of sources of your PD, in case they weren't provided by you

You also have the right to ask for rectification or erasure of your PD. You may also ask for restriction of using and processing your PD as well as raise an objection against processing your PD.

6. List of all PD processed and held by MEATEST is regularly registered and it is available upon request.
